Thoughts from the Pastor: Your Legacy

In the movie, "You Can't Take It with You" the main character, Grandpa Vanderhof, challenges the wealthy banker, A. P. Kirby, who is so absorbed by his financial dealings, that he has lost sight of the value of people. In series of hilarious incidents, they end up in jail together with a collection of petty criminals and needy people. During their jail stay, Grandpa tries to convince the senior Kirby to enjoy life instead of concentrating on making money: "You can't take it with you, Mr. Kirby. So what good is it? As near as I can see, **the only thing you can take with you is the love of your friends.**"

When the elder Kirby begins berating the criminals in the cell, Grandpa Vanderhof shifts gears from a laid-back kind of guy to an emotional speech, illustrating that anger and morality can co-exist:

What makes you think you are such a superior human being? Your money? If you do, you're a dull-witted fool, Mr. Kirby, and a poor one at that. Poorer than any of these people that you call scum because I'll guarantee at least they've got some friends, but you with your jungle and your long claws as you call them, you'll wind up your miserable existence without anything you can call a friend. You may be a high mogul to yourself, Mr. Kirby, but to me you're a failure. Failure as a man. Failure as a human being. Even a failure as a father.

That squarely hits the question of legacy... money or mankind...

Have you ever noticed that Paul closes his letters with a list of friends and colleagues to whom he gives tidbits of information and commands? Did you ever think that while Paul did much for the kingdom and blessed us with these God inspired letters, that his greatest legacy was in the hearts of those people?

The great British preacher, Charles Spurgeon said, "A good character is the best tombstone. Those who loved you and were helped by you will remember you when forget-me-nots have withered. Carve your name on hearts, not on marble."

What will your legacy be, a life about God and relationships?

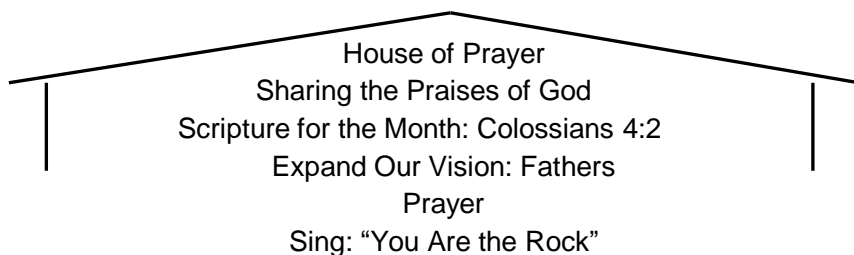
